Youth journalists plan reports from neighbouring municipalities for *Youth Bridges 10*

The November issue of the trilingual youth magazine *Youth Bridges* had a celebrity focus. Issue 9 came out featuring on the cover page the Macedonian pop star Adrian Gaxha, famous for recording his albums in both Albanian and Macedonian languages. "I will sing in four languages", reads the title of the exclusive interview Gaxha gave to *Youth Bridges* after his concert in Skopje in late November.



The ninth issue of the magazine focuses on music, and is the first thematic issue to be produced. Articles on the recent jazz festival in Kumanovo, a local rock band in Presevo, a pop music band from Silovo (Gjilan/Gnjilane municipality) and a heavy metal band from Kumanovo, reached out to fans of different music genres.

The *Youth Bridges* team met on 12 December in the EWI office in Gjilan/Gnjilane to plan the upcoming tenth issue, which will also have a thematic focus: sports. With publication planned for mid February, the issue will also naturally tackle the celebration of St. Valentine's Day, which is gaining more popularity in the region each year. From a more comic perspective, this next issue of *Youth Bridges* will also feature an article on 'sportsmanship' in romantic relationships.



In late December and early January the youth journalists will again undertake cross-border field reporting, travelling to neighbouring municipalities, as they did when reporting for Issue 5. After having reported on the nightlife scene in each town in the spring of 2006, the journalists will now write about school life in each of the four GPKT municipalities.
